



# CULTURAL ENRICHMENT AT MUSEUMS

## SAVANNAH AFRICAN ART MUSEUM



The Savannah African Art Museum holds a collection of over 1000 objects that hail from West and Central Africa. Prior to the Museum's founding in late 2016 this collection formed over the last 30 years by Mr. Don Kole, a Savannah businessman, private collector, and founder of the Savannah African Art Museum. Mr. Kole's collection of African art showcases a range of ceremonial and spiritual objects from the 19th and 20th centuries made from ceramics, metal, and wood. These powerful objects hold origins throughout West and Central Africa, representing 28 countries and over 150 individual cultures and ethnic groups. The diverse range of objects represented bisects the entire continent of Africa spanning as far west as Guinea and as far east as Tanzania. The Museum's collection spans over 28 Countries that bisect the continent of Africa, and represents over 180 cultures.

## SCAD MUSEUM



The SCAD Museum of Art is a premier contemporary art museum that features emerging and established international artists through commissioned works and rotating exhibitions.

**Mainly for Women**

Paulina Olowaska (b. 1976, Gdansk, Poland) lives and works in Rabka Zdroj and Krakow, Poland. She has presented solo exhibitions at Kunsthalle Basel; the Stedelijk Museum, Amsterdam; and the Zacheta National Gallery of Art, Warsaw. Olowaska received the prestigious Aachen Art Prize in 2014 and exhibited at the Ludwig Forum for International Art, Aachen, Germany. She has staged performances at Tate Modern, the Carnegie International, and The Museum of Modern Art, New York.

## TELFAIR MUSEUMS



Telfair Museums is the oldest public art museum in the South. The legacy of one visionary Savannahian, it was founded in 1883 through the bequest of prominent local philanthropist Mary Telfair, who left her home and its furnishings to the Georgia Historical Society to be opened as a museum. Today, Telfair Museums consists of three unique buildings: the Telfair Academy and the Owens-Thomas House & Slave Quarters, two National Historic Landmark sites built in the early 19th century, and the contemporary Jepson Center for the Arts. Each of the museum's three buildings represents an innovative expression of its time and houses a collection corresponding to the era in which it was built. Together, these three unique buildings and three distinct collections bridge centuries of art and architecture, illustrating the continuum of art and history in Savannah.

If you cannot affirm and attest to the information on the Attendee Health Attestation on the day of the event, you will not be permitted to attend the in-person event.**

## **Attendee Health Attestation**

**To do our part in preventing the spread of COVID-19, we are restricting attendance at any of our Executive Council meetings from anyone with knowledge that they have a COVID-19 Infection or have recently been exposed to the virus.**

**By attending any in-person Business Law Section events you are affirming and attesting that:**

**(a) You do not have a COVID-19 infection and are not currently experiencing or displaying, and have not in the last 14 days experienced or displayed, any of the following symptoms:**

**Fever or chills  
Cough  
Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing  
Fatigue  
Muscle or body aches  
Headache  
New loss of taste or smell  
Sore throat  
Congestion or runny nose  
Nausea or vomiting  
Diarrhea**



**(b) You have not in the last 14 days had any close contact with anyone who is either confirmed or suspected of being infected with COVID-19, including anyone who was experiencing or displaying any of the known symptoms of COVID-19.**

**(c) You have not in the last 14 days traveled from (1) areas of substantial community spreading requiring quarantine per the Florida Department of Health, or (2) traveled internationally based on the current US State Department Level 4 travel advisory for all international travel due to the global impact of COVID-19.**

**If you cannot affirm or attest to any of the above on the day of the event, please do not attend. There is a risk of COVID-19 exposure in any public place where people are present. COVID-19 is highly contagious and can lead to illness and death. By attending the event, you voluntarily assume all risks related to COVID-19 exposure. Thank you for your cooperation.**
