 - a. Somewhat subjective, not purely a matter of hours

 - c. Want to give weight to what somone has done, not just total quantity of hours
 - iv. Review of selection timeline
 - Angelique Gulia will handle doing the ranking spreadsheet (once we reach that stage)

 - 4. Have meeting about 2 weeks later to discuss

- c. Recognition of Pro Bono Heroes in Publications
 - i. Preference for publication over "swag" type gifts (discussion, all agree)
 - ii. Another suggestion: donation to public service organization in honor of one or two people (like for "Pro Bono Hero of the Year")
 - iii. Suggestion: put name on BLS landing page
 - 1. PB hero
 - 2. Person with highest number of hours
 - iv. Could add award profile or list to photo slideshow on BLS homepage
 - 1. Can use the existing space on the BLS homepage as needed (rotate out info as the year progresses)
 - v. GJ suggestion: Could use previous year's list of pro bono hours to create recognition
 - 1. Use prior list (based on last year's data) to select 4-5 people
 - 2. Put up profiles quarterly/semi-annually
 - 3. As part of this, make sure that communications person at the volunteer attorney's firm is informed (drive traffic to pledge website)
 - 4. People who can help
 - a. GJ will help draft paragraph profiles of top volunteers
 - b. TT to assist as time permits
 - 5. One possibility:
 - a. Template (prepared by TE) that will use a headshot and a quote from the featured volunteer
 - b. Feature becomes part of the slideshow on BLS homepage (rotating basis)
